# Site Director - Position Description OneLife Gap Year - OneLife at Sakanaga | Marietta, SC

**Position Summary:** The Site Director's primary responsibility is leading and facilitating mentorship of 25-35 gap year students. OneLife students live in a Gospel-centered community where they grow in faith and biblical knowledge (developing a Christian worldview), learn practical life skills, travel domestically and internationally, and earn up to 30 college credits.

The Site Director will need to be proactive and a self-starter. He or she will have a deep desire to see students grow in their relationship with God and knowledge of God's Word. Words associated with a Site Director include leader, shepherd, teacher, counselor, passionate, organized, and a team player.

A Site Director is passionate about helping young adults move from a stagnant faith in God, to a dynamic personal faith in Jesus and shift from a self-centered follower to an "others-centered" servant leader.

A Site Director is a crucial position that supports the mission and vision of OneLife through <u>Shepherding & Discipleship</u>, <u>Program Planning & Execution</u>, as well as <u>Leading & Building Site Staff</u> <u>Team & Partner Relationships</u>. The Site Director is a full-time position reporting to the Program Director.
