# PATH TO ENROLLMENT

**Get accepted and commit to OneLife first and then apply for college credits!**

## **Step 1. PRE-QUALIFY IN 3 MINUTES FOR FREE**

Take the first step on this life-changing journey! Find our pre-qualification form on our website and fill it out by providing basic contact information and briefly answering these 3 questions.

- Who is Jesus to you?
- Why do you think OneLife would be good for you?
- Why do you think you would be good for OneLife?

## **Step 2. SEND US A SPIRITUAL REFERENCE**

You can choose anyone outside of your family who knows your spiritual journey well. You will need to provide their relationship to you, their position, their email address and phone number. Directions for this step are on our website.

## **Step 3. SCHEDULE AN INTERVIEW**

If you qualify, we will schedule a 45-60 minute intentional video conversation with you to make sure you are the right fit for our program and that we are the best fit for you.

Upon receiving an admissions decision from OneLife's Director of Enrollment, your next step is to submit a non-refundable reservation fee to save your seat at OneLife. Please note: sites have limited capacity and fill up quickly.
